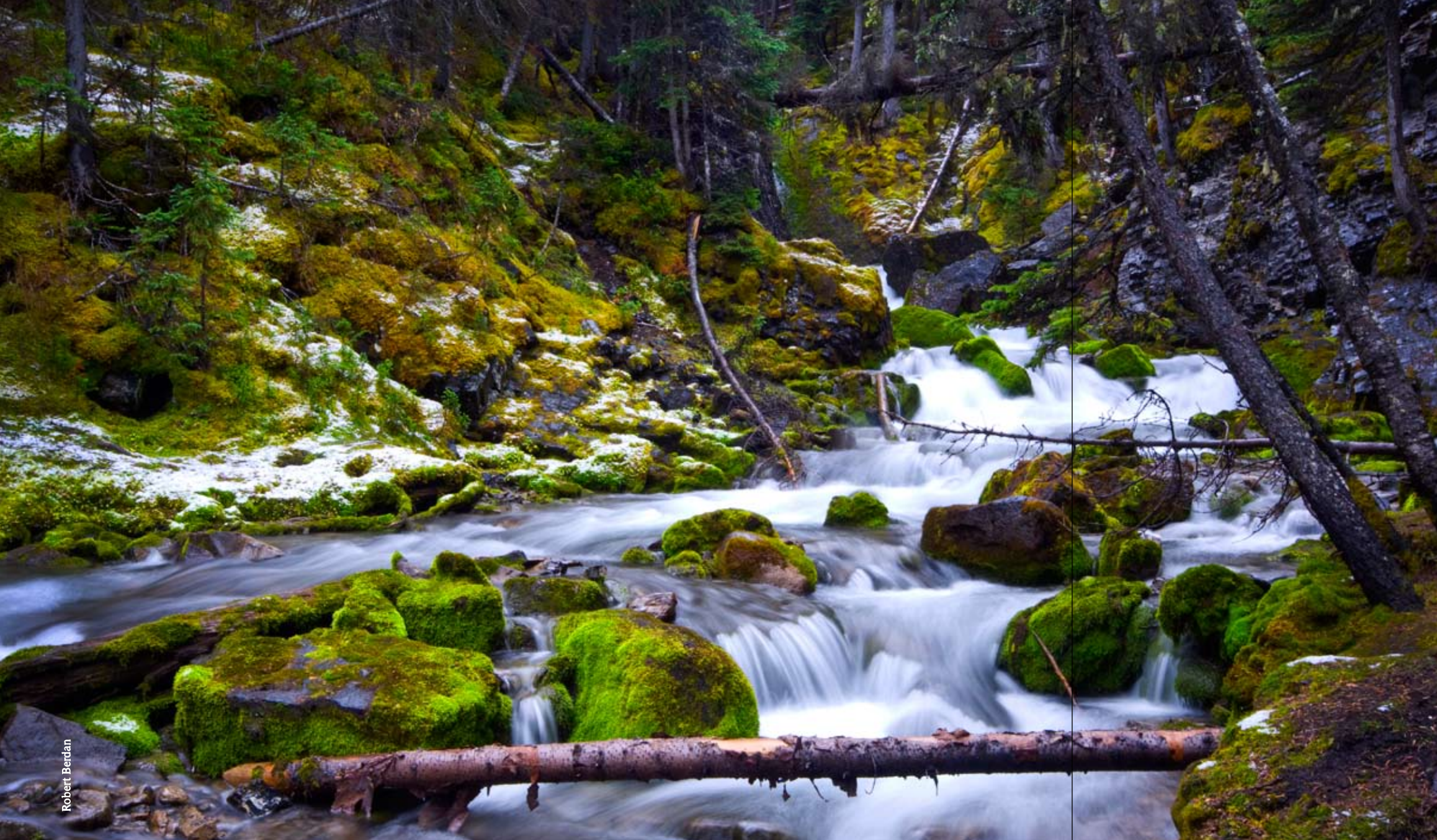


Take a Path Less Travelled

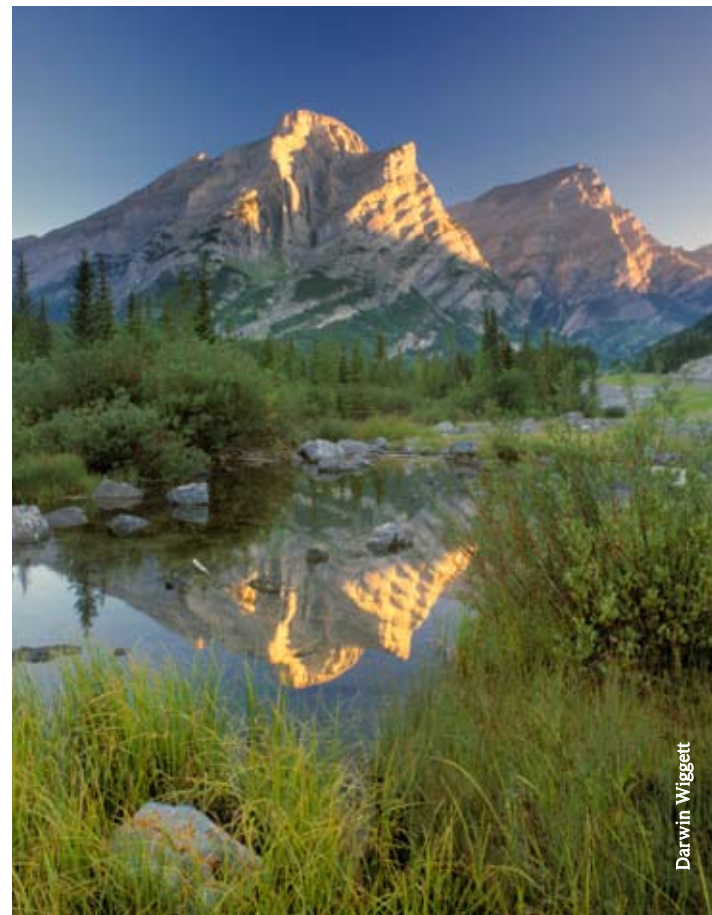

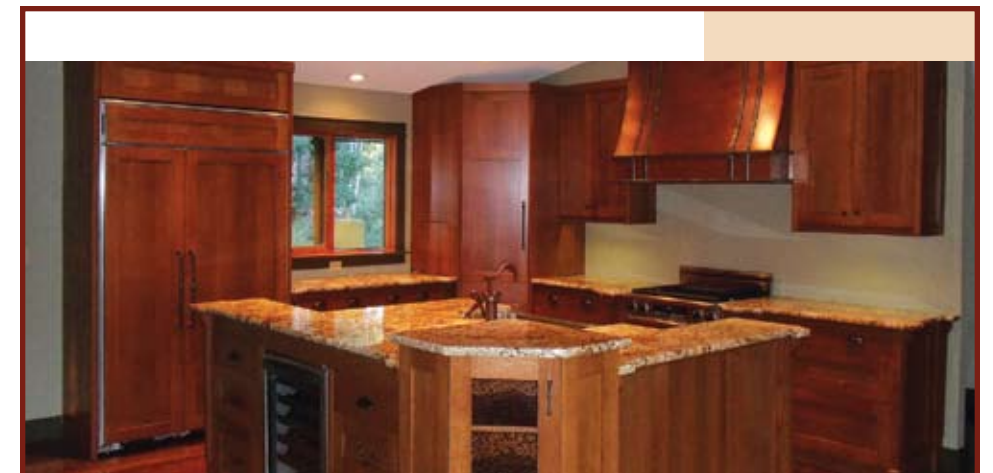
